Thank you for choosing Camp Chadwick for your child(ren) to attend this summer. We are excited to get to know your child and provide a safe, fun-filled, memorable camp experience. Please find some information below that will help make this camp season a success.

Camp will run for seven weeks (Mon-Fri) from June 30th to August 15th with the exception of Friday, July 4th. We operate our camp daily from 8:30am - 4:00pm with the option of early drop off or late pick up for an additional fee.
